



# Industry Forecast

## Eurozone

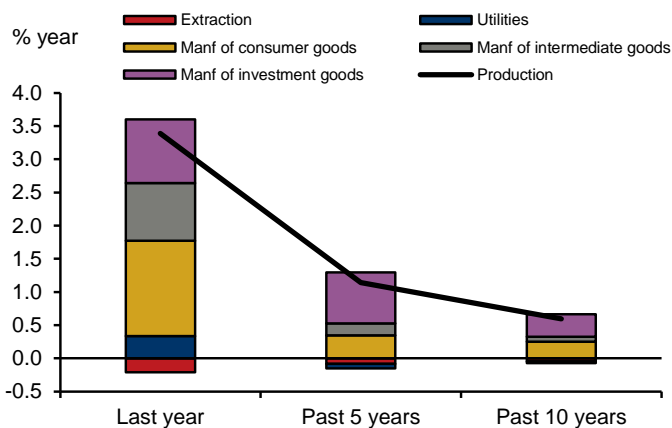
### Overview

- GDP is expected to rise by 1.6% in 2016 and expand by 1.5% in 2017. Over the next 10 years to 2025, GDP is predicted to grow on average by 1.5% a year.
- Manufacturing output growth is forecast to be lower than GDP growth over the next decade. Manufacturing output is expected to increase by 1.4% in 2016 and expand by 1.3% in 2017. Over the next 10 years to 2025, manufacturing output is expected to grow on average by 1.4% a year.
- As a result, the share of manufacturing output in GDP is projected to fall from 16.6% in 2015 to 16.5% by 2020 and fall to 16.4% by 2025. Over the same period, the share of service sector output in GDP is expected to expand from 73.9% in 2015 to 74.1% in 2020 and rise to 74.3% in 2025.
- The three fastest growing sectors in manufacturing over the next decade will be medical & surgical equipment, aerospace and telecommunication equipment. The slowest growing sectors will be oil & natural gas extraction, man-made fibres and other extraction activities.
- The overall value of industrial production in 2015 was €1,743.8 billion at 2010 prices. Within this, the largest sectors are utilities (€233.9 billion), metal products n.e.c (€149.1 billion) and food (€133.2 billion). By 2020 industrial production will total €1,866.1 billion (2010 prices), rising to €1,986.0 billion by 2025. The largest sectors in 2025 will be utilities (€259.9 billion), metal products n.e.c (€173.1 billion) and food (€153.6 billion).
- The share of consumer goods in total manufacturing output was 28.4% in 2015: by 2025 this is predicted to decline to 27.6%. The share of investment goods is expected to increase from 40.0% to 41.5% over the same period, while the share of intermediate goods is forecast to fall from 31.7% to 30.9%.
- Construction output is expected to increase by 2.1% in 2016 and expand by 1.8% in 2017. Over the 10 years to 2025, construction output is expected to grow on average by 1.8% a year.
- Overall industrial production (manufacturing, extraction and utilities) is forecast to increase by 1.1% in 2016 and expand by 1.4% in 2017. This compares with an increase in world industrial production of 1.4% in 2016 and rise of 2.5% in 2017. Over the 10 years to 2025, industrial production in Eurozone is expected to grow on average by 1.3% a year, compared with a growth rate of 2.6% a year for the world as a whole.
- As a result, the share of Eurozone in world industrial production should fall from 14.6% in 2016 to 13.8% by 2020 and decline to 12.9% by 2025.
- Services are expected to rise by 1.7% in 2016 and expand by 1.6% in 2017. Over the next 10 years to 2025, the service sector is predicted to grow on average by 1.6% a year.

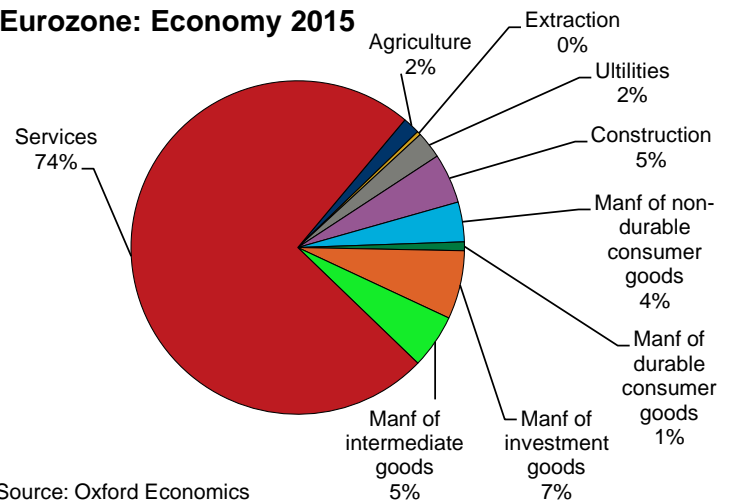


**Eurozone: Economy 2015**



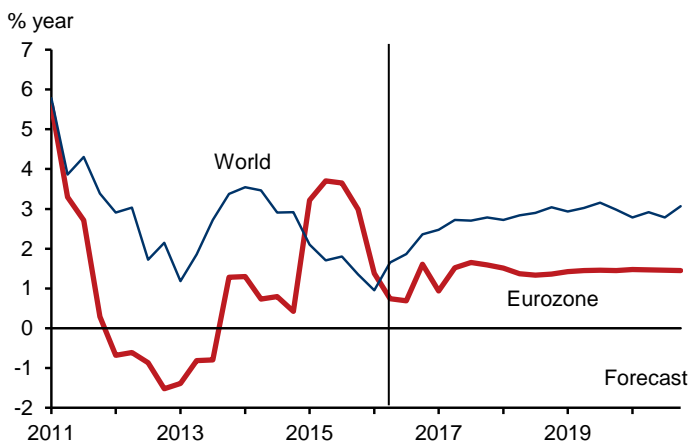

**Eurozone: Economy 2015**



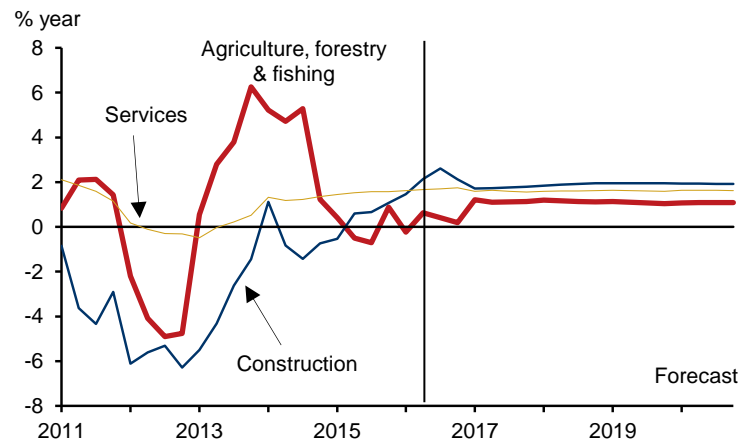

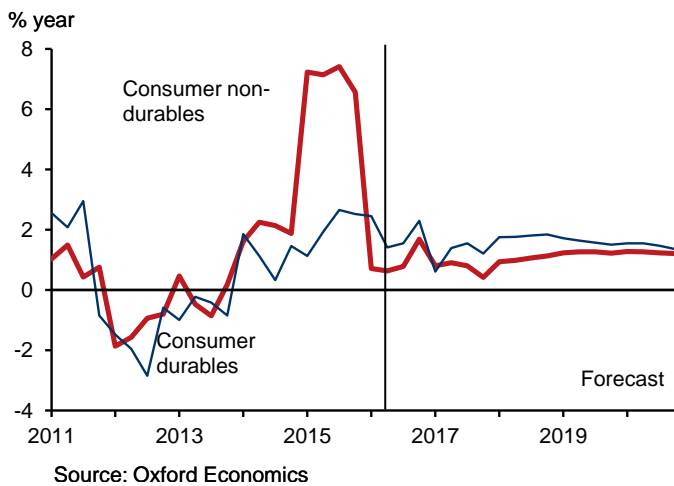
**Eurozone: Industrial Structure 2015**



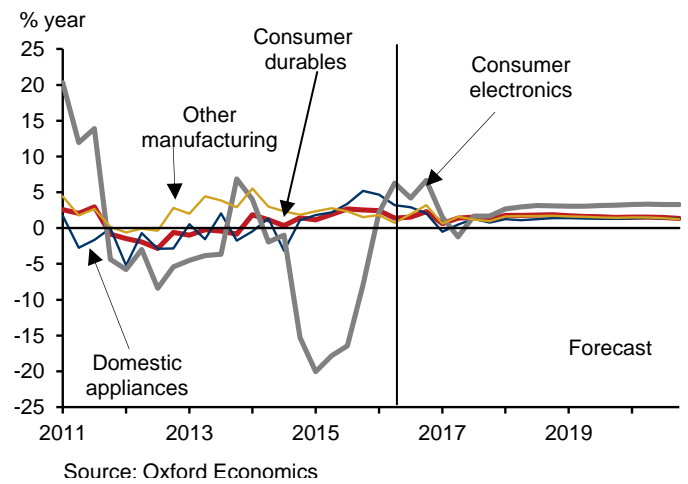
**Eurozone: Output of manufacturing**



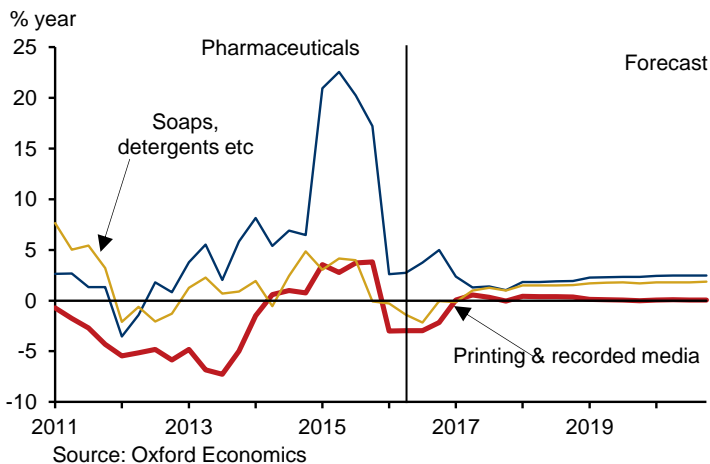
**Eurozone: Consumer goods**



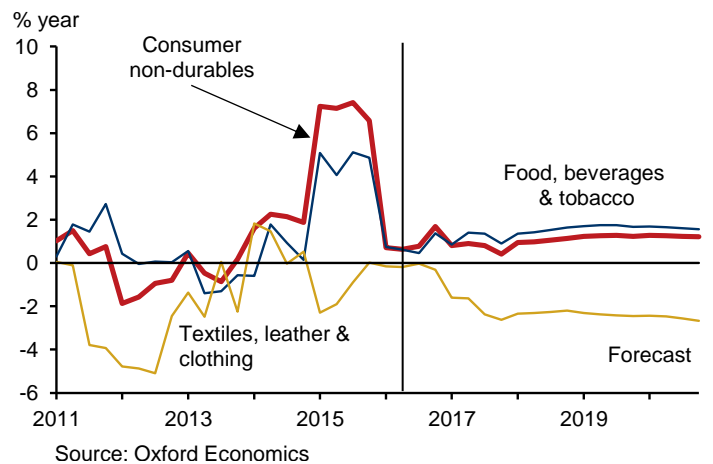
**Eurozone: Consumer durable goods**
