



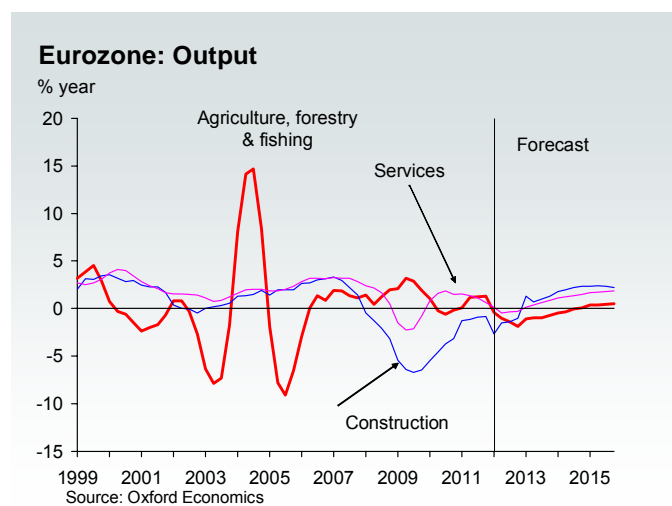
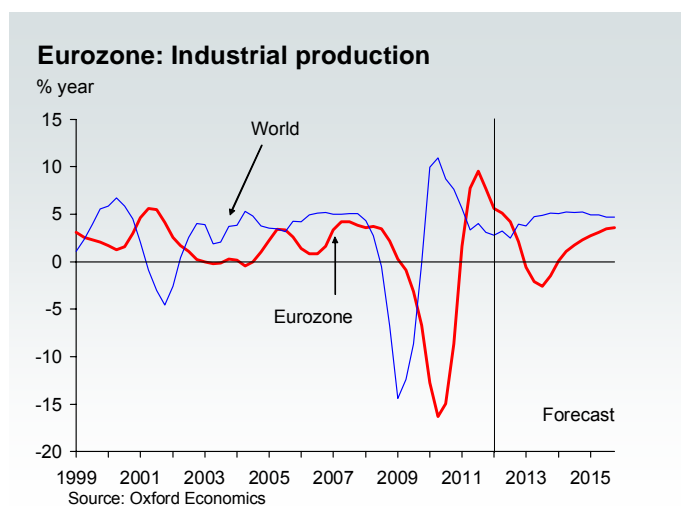
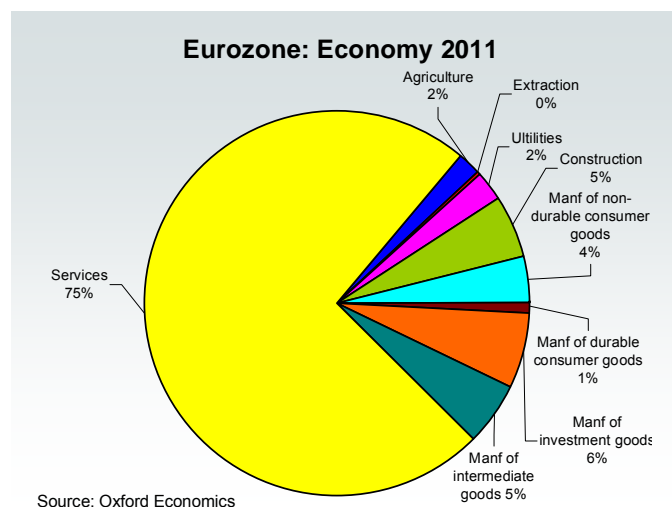
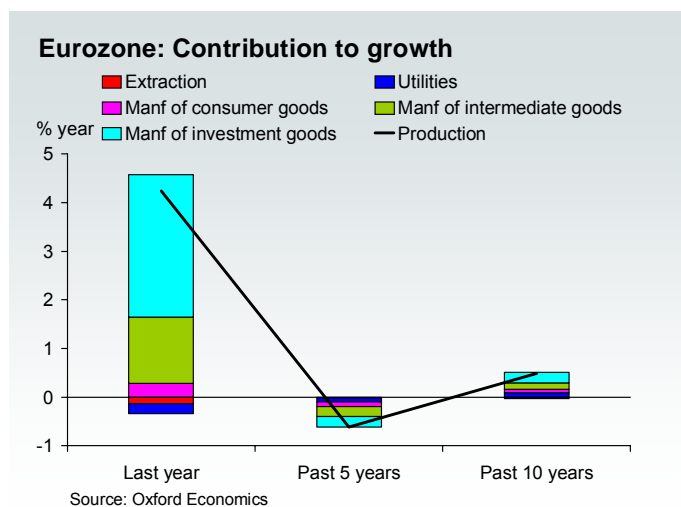
Overview

- GDP is expected to fall by 0.4% in 2012 and expand by 1.0% in 2013. Over the next 10 years to 2021, GDP is predicted to grow on average by 1.5% a year.
- Manufacturing output growth is forecast to be higher than GDP growth over the next decade. Manufacturing output is expected to decrease by 1.7% in 2012 and expand by 1.5% in 2013. Over the next 10 years to 2021, manufacturing output is expected to grow on average by 1.8% a year.
- As a result, the share of manufacturing output in GDP is projected to rise from 16.6% in 2011 to 17.2% by 2016 and decrease to 17.1% by 2021. Over the same period, the share of service sector output in GDP is expected to decline from 73.5% in 2011 to 73.1% in 2016 and rise to 73.5% in 2021.
- The three fastest growing sectors in manufacturing over the next decade will be aerospace, other general purpose machinery and electronic components & boards. The slowest growing sectors will be leather goods, textiles and man-made fibres.
- The overall value of industrial production in 2011 was €1,287.6 billion at 2005 prices. Within this, the largest sectors are utilities (€184.8 billion), food (€129.6 billion) and metal products n.e.c (€119.9 billion). By 2016 industrial production will total €1,416.9 billion (2005 prices), rising to €1,540.0 billion by 2021. The largest sectors in 2021 will be utilities (€207.6 billion), metal products n.e.c (€151.2 billion) and food (€144.0 billion).
- The share of consumption goods in total manufacturing output was 29.5% in 2011: by 2021 this is predicted to decline to 26.8%. The share of investment goods is expected to increase to 40.2% from 37.4% over the same period, while the share of intermediate goods is forecast to fall from 33.1% to 33.0%.
- Construction output is expected to decrease by 1.7% in 2012 and expand by 1.0% in 2013. Over the 10 years to 2021, construction output is expected to grow on average by 1.3% a year.
- Overall industrial production (manufacturing, extraction and utilities) is forecast to fall by 1.7% in 2012 and expand by 1.3% in 2013. This compares with an increase in world industrial production of 3.0% in 2012 and rise of 4.1% in 2013. Over the 10 years to 2021, industrial production in Eurozone is expected to grow on average by 1.7% a year, compared with a growth rate of 3.8% a year for the world as a whole.
- As a result, the share of the Eurozone in world industrial production should fall from 16.5% in 2012 to 15.4% by 2016 and decline to 14.1% by 2021.
- Services are expected to fall by 0.2% in 2012 and expand by 0.5% in 2013. Over the next 10 years to 2021, services are predicted to grow on average by 1.5% a year.

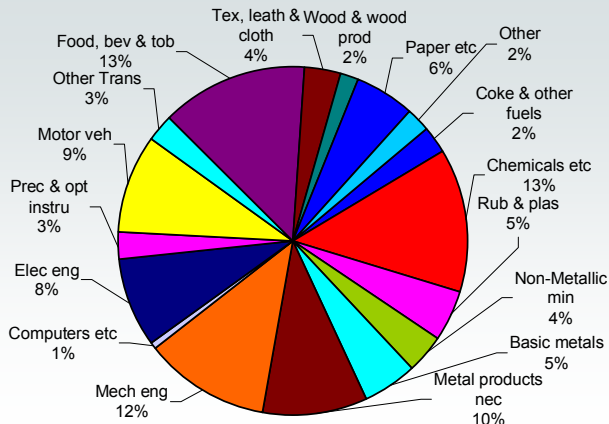

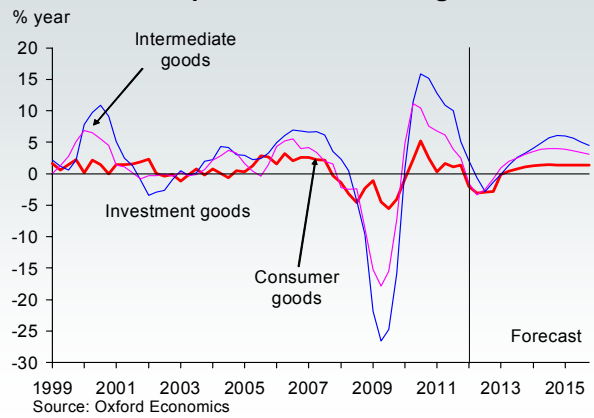

Industrial structure 2011



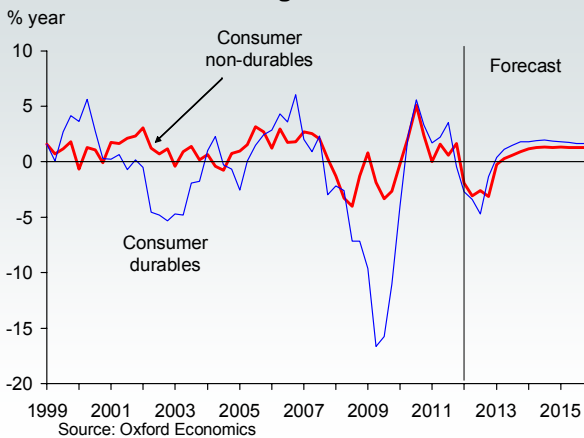

Eurozone: Output of manufacturing



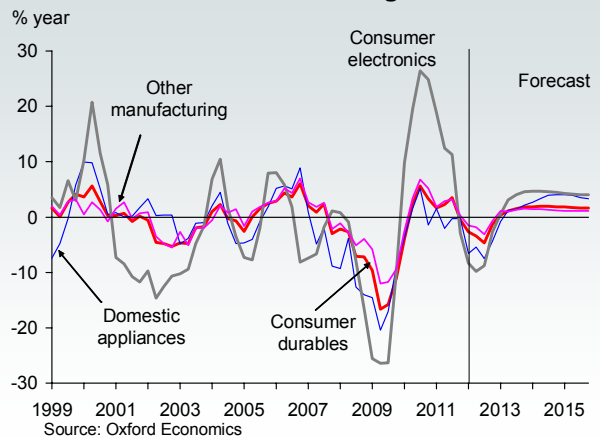

Eurozone: Consumer goods



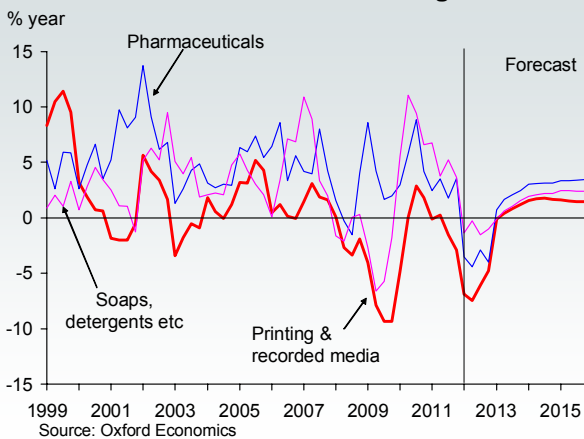

Eurozone: Consumer durable goods



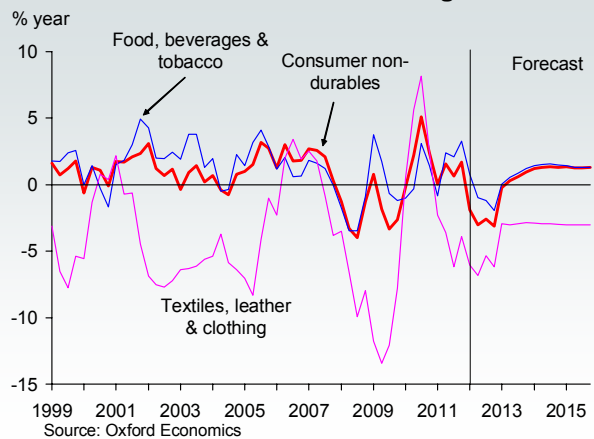

Eurozone: Consumer non-durable goods



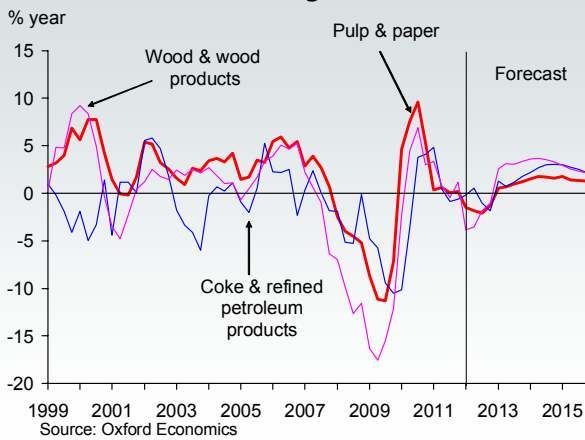

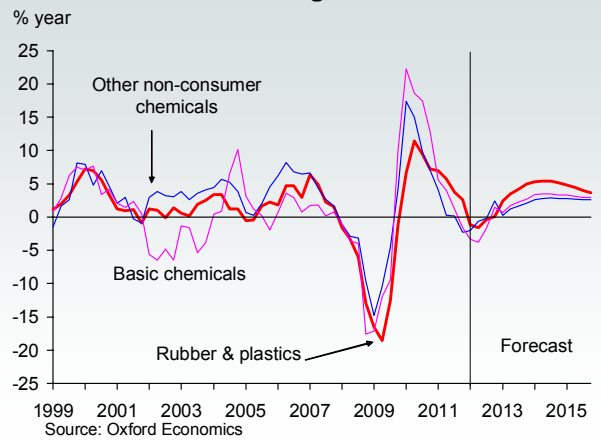

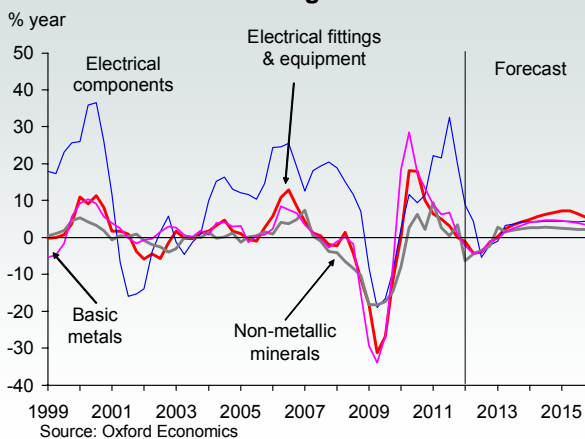
Eurozone: Intermediate goods



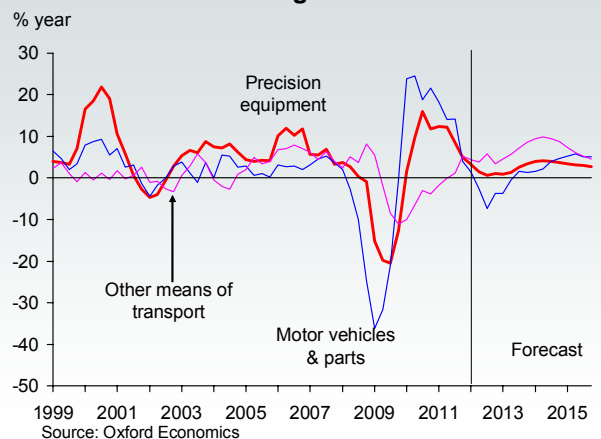

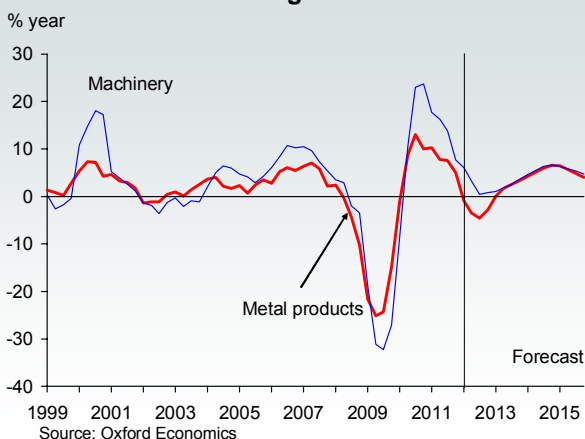

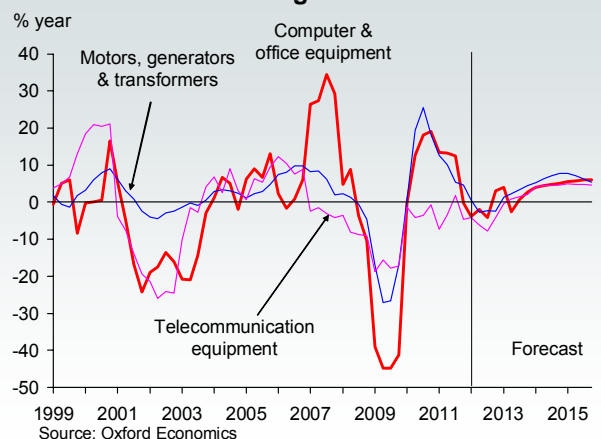
